Negotiate and execute supplier agreements for best use of cash flow and inventory in sync with overall business strategy.

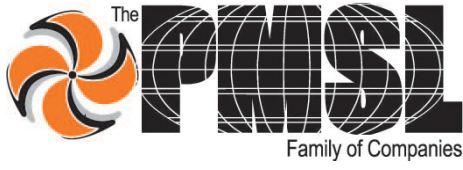
Travels domestically and internationally to visit suppliers to verify capabilities and to develop and qualify new vendors.
